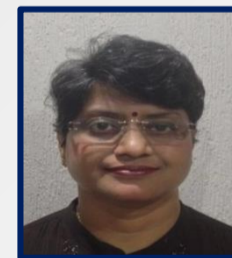

**Keywords:** Include 5-6 keywords that highlight the main themes or topics of your research.

**Title and Author Information:** Clearly state the title of your paper at the beginning of the abstract. Follow this with the name of the authors, their designation, the name of the institution, and the email ID of the presenting author.

**Plagiarism Check:** All submissions must be original and free from plagiarism. Ensure that your abstract does not contain content directly copied from other sources without proper citation. The author will be responsible for any plagiarism related issues.
